“Our mission experience to Joppa Mountain has impacted us for life. The “dailiness” of our experiences brought the gospel alive. 8 unique team members were fashioned into a collective group of mind/spirit to minister in the name of Jesus. We spared precious money and left behind the comforts of home (family/friends, work, agendas, TV, telephone, clocks, alcohol, and pride) to serve and be served.

The week emulated the parable of the loaves and fishes. At St. Michael the Archangel in Erwin, TN and Glenmary missions we witnessed how a few people have formed congregations that worship, teach, minister, celebrate and mourn together. On Joppa Mountain meager tools became instruments to construct a woman's mountain view porch and reconstruct mission bunk beds. Paint/water revitalized a tiny ministry house, children's residences, porch floors and furniture. Water, soap and sweat rejuvenated a mission center.

Strangers at a nursing home and firehouse became friends with kind words, Bingo, hugs and handshakes, food and music. Glenmary missionaries became extended family through reflections, stories, laughs, smiles, sweat, worship, rosaries, adoration. We had prayer/chats around tables, counters, in vehicles, restaurants, roadsides, on mountains and by rivers. Persons of different faiths, ethnic groups and backgrounds ministered to us with hugs, handshakes, prayers, smiles, music and life-sustaining food and drink. A husband/wife shared their living and beautiful pottery objects amidst their daily struggles. In awe we witnessed our team member take a blank canvas and create an inspired wall hanging representing our parish mission. Another member broke barriers by strumming a guitar to bring forth singing, dancing, joy and tears. Other members offered themselves by reading, constructing, driving, shopping, cooking, cleaning to bring life and hope. In all of this God was very alive and present.

This trip reminded us that daily God uses the simple things of our lives to reach us. Smiles, hugs, handshakes, words, meager tools, food, drink, music. We all have something to share with others if we can put aside our private agendas, clocks, phones, TVs, alcohol and pride.

We are grateful for your support of our service with your donations of money, supplies and prayers. We were proud to represent our St. Mary parishes and larger community.”

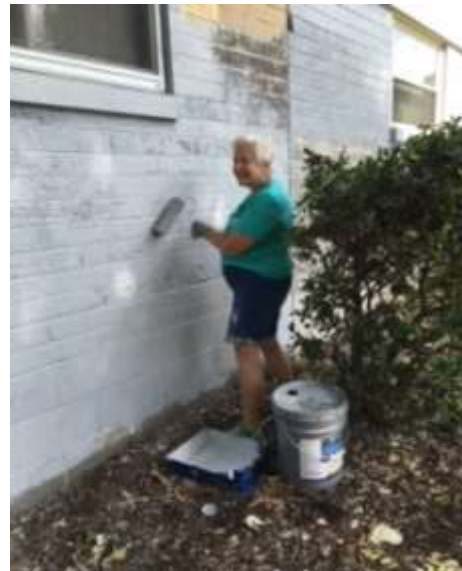
