

PASTORAL PONDERINGS

Give it all to God and all will be well. It is so comforting to do that when everything in our life is going well. However, when we come up against situations that are difficult, when it seems a black cloud hangs permanently over our head, it is hard to give it all to God.

As you read this, hopefully God has moved me through a period of my life where I felt worried and stressed and really struggled to give it to God. On April 10th I had total knee replacement surgery. My right knee was replaced seven years ago, so I did have some understanding of the process and knew that in these days of healing and recovery, there are going to be some tough times; but God never fails. Yet in the weeks leading up to the surgery I would allow myself to slip into doubts, fears, and overwhelming negative self-talk. It sounded like this: "Did I make the right decision? What if.... (Insert worst case scenario here.) What if this doesn't work? Maybe this choice wasn't the best one, I wonder..."

This is a normal human reaction, but it slows one's progress and steals contentment and peace. We beat ourselves up and allow overthinking to eat at our soul and prayer begins to feel empty. I found I would give it to God, and then just as quickly say "You know God, you are moving kind of slowly on this, I think You need my help! (Insert roll of eyes from God here!) These are some of the things I found to be of help to me as I prepared for surgery and hopefully will continue to help in my recovery.

Pray with honesty. "I trust you God, but I am feeling so anxious..." Express what you are feeling to a friend or spiritual director or make a list of all your "what if's." Putting words to our fears often bring them to light and they fade away or become less disruptive. Embrace Grace. There is no need to ask God for Grace, God graced us to perfection when we took our first breath. Our challenge to accept Grace, to give it space to fill our mind, body, and spirit.

Be willing to adapt and allow others to help you. "I'm strong, I'm independent, I can handle this." Well, yes, we are, but does that leave room for Grace to move; the Grace that comes from others covering you in their prayers or doing things they feel will help you and make your day a little better and brighter? I feel so blessed going through this surgery with our Pastoral Staff having my back. They are incredible people of prayer, support, and Grace!

Pay attention to God guiding your steps. I realize that for me, right now, some of those steps will come with a fair amount of "ouch" and crankiness, but I need to leave room for Grace. (Pray for my niece Pamela who is coming from Southern Indiana to spend the first week "tending to" her old, maybe cranky, Auntie.)

In all things. Wait for God's timing and Praise God for a love that goes beyond human understanding. Please keep me in your prayers.


