### **PASTORAL PONDERINGS**

Most people think of Easter as a single day. It's never had the commercial appeal of Christmas, and because it's always on a Sunday, most people don't get any additional days off from work. But for Catholics, Easter isn't just a day, it's a whole season. The Easter season is 50 days long and stretches all the way to the feast of Pentecost. It's not only a season, but a celebration; an invitation to joy.

During Lent we tend to excel at the reflective practices. Lent is a time of laying things aside, to create more space for Christ in our lives, to develop practices that open us up to the risen Jesus. We spent 40 days in the wilderness, searching our souls, failing, and resting in grace. Lent prepares us for Easter, where we celebrated our hearts out until they were overflowing with joy.

It seems like we put more energy into Lent than Easter. We are now in the Easter season. It is a time to remember that Jesus was not in a rush to ascend into heaven. Jesus spent time appearing to his disciples and preparing them for Pentecost. I invite us to joyfully celebrate the resurrection of our Lord and Savior so we can become better prepared for the Feast of Pentecost.

Here are some ways to celebrate during these 50 days:

- -The Easter season is a time of celebration! The Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary are particularly fitting for this time. Pray a decade as a family each night.
- -Use a special candle at family meals to recall the light of Christ.
- -Every day, read together a section from the Easter story in one of the four gospels.
- -Put up a sign or banner that proclaims, "He is risen!"
- -Add three alleluias to your prayers each day.
- -Do a family act of kindness for a person in need to express thanks for the resurrection.
- -Celebrate life by doing something as a family to support unborn children and their parents.
- -Get a container of blessed water from the church and bless your family members each day.
- -Place a resurrection icon or picture in a place of honor.
- -Read Luke 24:50-53 or Acts 1:6-11 and ask family members to imagine themselves present at Jesus' ascension.

Do not try to do all of these things. I invite you to just pick a few ideas that seem right for you.



#### **How to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet**

- 1. Make the sign of the cross.
- 2. Opening prayer: You expired Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us. O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You! (3 times).
- 3. Our Father
- 4. Hail Mary
- 5. Apostles Creed
- 6. On each of the 5 large "Our Father" beads pray:
  Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.
- On each of the 10
   "Hail Mary" beads
   pray:
   For the sake of His
   sorrowful Passion,

- have mercy on us and on the whole world.
- 8. Concluding prayer:
  Holy God, Holy
  Mighty One, Holy
  Immortal One, have
  mercy on us and on
  the whole world. (3
  times).
- 9. Closing Prayer: Eternal God, in Whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments, we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself. Amen.





### The ABCs of Divine Mercy

Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.

Be Merciful to Others. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.

**Completely Trust in Jesus.** God wants us to know that the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive.

To observe Divine Mercy Sunday, we should:

- Celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday on the Sunday after Easter
- \* Sincerely repent of all sins
- Place complete trust in Jesus
- \* Go to confession
- Receive communion on Divine Mercy Sunday
- Venerate the image of Divine Mercy
- Be merciful to others through actions, words and prayers


