

Pope Francis has said "Lent is a favorable season for opening the doors to all those in need and recognizing in them the face of Christ."

We as Catholics are called to focus more on giving during Lent so that we can grow in love by being charitable to our fellow brothers and sisters in Christ. Giving not only fills the Lord with joy, but it fills our own hearts with joy as well. We are told to give our time, talent, and treasure to the church and to others.

We are to challenge ourselves by giving and to prepare for Christ to transform our hearts through our generosity. As we are in the early stages of Lent, I invite you to consider some of the following ways to give to others. Some of these ideas may push us out of our comfort zone, but that's the point! God is waiting for us outside of our comfort zones, ready to walk with us as we serve His people.


- 1. Buy something for the person behind you in line.

- 3. Give unique compliments to five people.
- 4. Tell a loved one how much they mean to you.
- 5. Do a chore that is not yours.
- 6. Leave a thoughtful note for someone.
- 7. Send a care package to a person in the military.
- 8. Call a family member.
- 9. Give up social media for the day.
- 10. Tell Jesus you love him and why.

- 11. Bring a friend or loved one to Adoration.
- 12. Smile and say hello to a stranger.
- 13. Pray to God right away in the morning.
- 14. Ask a cashier how they are doing.
- 15. Donate blood.
- 16. Go to confession.
- 17. Volunteer at a nursing home.
- 18. Go to daily Mass.
- 19. Attend Stations of the Cross.
- 20. Let someone help you.

I hope we can accept this challenge and find the time this Lent to put some of these ideas into action so that we can deepen our love for God and our neighbor.




