PASTORAL PONDERINGS

Jesus was very intentional about tending to his spiritual growth. Scriptures recount him going to the desert or the mountains to be silent and pray. If Jesus, who knew his Father God most intimately needed to make time to be alone with God, then certainly that has to be the case for each one of us as well.

During the season of Lent you are being provided with a special and rich opportunity to be with the Lord in prayer and contemplation. Each of the weekends of Lent, twenty minutes prior to Mass beginning, you will find the Blessed Sacrament in exposition. (Jesus, covered under the form of a host is in a glass case, in a Monstrance, which is placed on the altar. Jesus will be in our immediate presence Body, Soul, and Divinity. You will have the opportunity to be at the pinnacle of the mountain with Jesus and you did not even have to make the climb!

What are we supposed to do when there is Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament? First, we maintain a spirit of silence within the church and between one another.

Next, I recommend you do nothing! It's that easy. Slip into your pew, slow down your breathing and as the Cure of Ars said, "I look at Jesus and Jesus looks at me." Converse with Jesus. Conversation means you must give Jesus His time to speak.



You may wish to use formal prayer. Many people chose to say the rosary or turn to some of the prayers that are in our missalette. Use your words of adoration, thanksgiving, and supplication. Jesus knows what is on your heart, so again, have a conversation with Him.

It would be an excellent time to open the missalette and read the Gospel for the Day.

When you enter the pew, the usual genuflection is used. The double knee genuflection that some of you may remember from your childhood is no longer required. You determine what posture is most conducive to you being with Jesus. You may kneel or sit. Perhaps imagine yourself sitting at His feet as his disciples did.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is a beautiful tradition of the Church.

For many years it did lose its place in our Liturgical Life, but as our world becomes more broken and filled with loss and fear, the Church is drawing us back to being with Jesus in this special way.

"But it does nothing for me!" Jesus is good with that. Jesus is willing to just be with you, gazing at you, pouring his love upon you. Let Jesus, be Jesus and minister to you, only God knows, how he will draw you to Himself.

Please, care for your Spiritual Life this Lent by making a commitment to come to church twenty minutes early, or even ten. During this time on earth Jesus was in the desert alone in prayer, tending to his soul. You do not have to enter the barren desert on your own, come to the mountain top and be not only with Jesus, but with the whole Community of Believers.
