PASTORAL PONDERINGS

Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity. 1 Timothy 4:12

I believe Timothy knew what he was talking about. I too feel like I am a champion for our young people. We can learn so much from them. They are so open, honest, and like little sponges waiting to learn how they can be more like Jesus.

I really can't encourage you enough to join us some Wednesday afternoon for Mass (watch bulletin for dates) with our Elementary students. It is so beautiful! There is so much excitement on their faces as they literally run over to church from school asking "are we going to Mass today?" Each class is given opportunities to participate in the liturgy. From setting up for Mass and ringing the bell to proclaiming the Gospel while standing on a stepstool at the ambo. The children show us that they are part of our community of faith. "..., but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity." Their voices ring out in song and prayer during that Mass and it just melts my heart and reminds me to slow down and take this opportunity with our Lord for His light is shining bright in and through each one of those children.

Our St. Mary Winneconne students are not only setting examples for us at Mass but for each other in the classroom.

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, as in all wisdom you teach and admonish one another, singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God. And whatever you do, in word or in deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. Colossians 3:12-17

A Light to Others Award is awarded to the most helpful student in the class. This student shows kindness and compassion during class. This student puts others first, by helping classmates and the catechist. They strive to give assistance to whoever needs it.

Enlighten and Engage Award is awarded to the student that goes above and beyond to engage and participate in class discussions and activities. This student, while eager, remembers to follow classroom rules to ensure a respectful and peaceful classroom.



In celebration of the **Students of the Month** we will have a monthly recognition at Mass. Students and their families will be invited to join us at Mass where they will have an opportunity to participate in the Mass, be recognized, and blessed for their Christ-like behavior in the classroom, receive a certificate and gift, and join us for refreshments—refreshments that they had a hand in selecting! 
