PASTORAL PONDERINGS

This weekend is named Gaudete Sunday – the Sunday of joy. It, along with Laetare Sunday in Lent, are the two days when you may see Rose colored Vestments worn by the priest at Mass.



This past Tuesday as I read over the Sunday scriptures, I noted

they called us to proclaim good tidings to the poor, to the broken hearted, to those who are at wits end. Up to this point, Advent has been happily advent-full for me. I have enjoyed watching for God's presence in the most unexpected of places. I have taken a little extra time to pray, to put out a few decorations, and even stay fairly up to date on my Day-by-Day Scripture Advent Calendar (only a few days behind,) and on my Chocolate Advent Calendar (in that case, "Happy New year.")

However, this week's challenge to proclaim "glad tidings" is not looking good. My glad tidings may fall flat to the parishioner who just found out that after 30 loyal years to the Company, she is losing her job. Glad tidings will be hard to convey to a friend who has undergone yet another surgery with no insurance and is recovering in a cold house because FEMA has yet to come through with a flood loan applied for this past summer. How do I say "rejoice" to another acquaintance who is living with a pregnancy filled with serious health issues, or "rejoice" to one of our elderly men who took a fall and may have to move to a nursing home? How do I convey a spirit of rejoicing to the family who on the 23rd, amidst everyone else in full Christmas mode, will be having the funeral for their Father?

One answer lies in this weekend's Second Reading, "In all circumstances give thanks for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus." God promises that in the hour of greatest trial consolation is promised to us along with the great support and intercession from the Communion of Saints in heaven. This is not a "hope" that things might turn out well for us, rather, this is a rock-solid promise, rooted in the unshakeable character of God who is loving and faithfully watching over us.

You may think now that you will not be able to bear a difficulty that lies in your path. But God is always present. Seek to be holy; seek to bring truth; seek to bear witness; and do not turn aside from the chance to do good.

- * **Receive** and recognize each day, the blessings God has set before you.
- Renew each day your belief, that you belong to God and in all things God's Spirit is within you.
- Rejoice because in even the darkest moments, the Spirit gives to us enough of God to satisfy our soul and carry us through.
