PASTORAL PONDERINGS

As we are entering Advent, we look to Mary as a model of how we should be living the days of this season. Advent is a time to prepare our hearts and minds so that we will be ready to RECEIVE, be RENEWED, and REJOICE as we anticipate the coming of Jesus Christ through Mary!



Over the past few months I have had several encounters with pregnant women. Two girlfriends have daughters that are expecting. My niece just gave birth to her second son, Nolan Rex. Bodour and Ahmad, the refugee couple from Jordan, have received the gift of their first child, a beautiful little girl, Massa!

The unknowns and new experiences of pregnancy are beautiful; the first flutters in the belly, the baby kicks, the deep desire to protect and comfort, the hopes and dreams for the life within. Most likely there is a bit of fear about the unknown too.

In the Annunciation (Luke 1:26-38 see below) we see how Mary experienced all of this as Christ bearer! Take a few minutes to ponder this reading. What word or words capture your attention?

"Greetings, favoured one! The Lord is with you." But she was much perplexed by his words and pondered what sort of greeting this might be. The angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favour with God. And now, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you will name him Jesus. He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give to him the throne of his ancestor David. He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end." Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I am a virgin?" The angel said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be holy; he will be called Son of God. And now, your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son; and this is the sixth month for her who was said to be barren. For nothing will be impossible with God."

Then Mary said,

"Here am I, the servant of the Lord; let it be with me according to your word." Then the angel departed from her.

As you read this passage a second time, consider placing yourself in the scene. Reflect on how Mary received the message and accepted the mission without hesitation. Her circumstances were far from perfect, yet her faith in God unwavering. Reflect on the faith and courage it must have taken her to embrace her calling to be the mother of Jesus. Do you sense the peace and confidence in Mary's response? Consider praying for that same faith and courage today and to receive peace through the "yes" or "new life" you are being called to.

As you read it a third time, rest in how God is rejoicing in you! Experience a renewed heart as you receive Jesus through His Word. Rejoice in God who is faithful, who works within us as we sit in the classroom of silence and respond to him with faith. As you conclude your prayer, consider journaling about your prayer experience.

As we look to Mary as a model on how to live Advent, remember two great ways to receive, renew and rejoice are spending time in God's Word and receiving Jesus in the Eucharist!




