# PASTORAL PONDERINGS

OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults) is the structured process by which adults move from initial inquiry into full communion with the Catholic Church through stages and liturgical rites such as the Rite of Acceptance, Rite of Welcoming, Rite of Election, and ultimately receiving the sacraments of initiation at Easter. The Rite of Welcoming, often combined with the Rite of Acceptance, is one of its first public steps, which many parishes place near the beginning of Advent because of the season's themes of waiting and conversion, and because it is the beginning a new liturgical year. Advent does not require this rite, but the symbolism of beginning another level of conversion as the Church begins a new year makes perfect sense.

The Rite of Acceptance is for the unbaptized known as inquirers and signifies a change in identity as **"inquirers"** become **"catechumens"** officially recognized as members of the Church community. The Rite of Welcoming is for those baptized in a different Christian Denomination or adults already baptized in the Catholic Church but have not completed the other sacraments of initiation. The baptized are known as **"candidates"** and through the Rite of Welcoming, the candidates are formally introduced to the parish community. These rites emphasize both the intent of the inquirers and candidates to continue formation and conversion and the community's commitment to support them.

A couple weekends ago we warmly welcomed Miranda Peach, a candidate who wishes to continue on the path to full communion in the Catholic Church and who appreciates our prayers and support for her. As Miranda continues this journey of faith intentionally and with fervor, may we who have been in the Catholic Church for a long time, be inspired to enter more deeply into this season of Advent and into learning more about and practicing our Catholic faith more fully.

The following will help us get to know and pray more intentionally for Miranda:

1. Who is your Patron Saint? Mary Magdalene
2. What led you to OCIA?

After feeling a Divine Presence my entire life, it is Our Mother Mary that truly led me to where I am. I decided to join OCIA because of the pull I felt from not just the trinity, but from Mary showing herself to me through the actions and words of others. Our Blessed Mother has graciously widened my perspective and led me home to her Son.

3. What are you most excited about as you complete your full initiation into the Catholic Church?

I am most excited to give back to Jesus. I have always felt His presence, but as I deepen my faith, I feel Him with me more than ever.

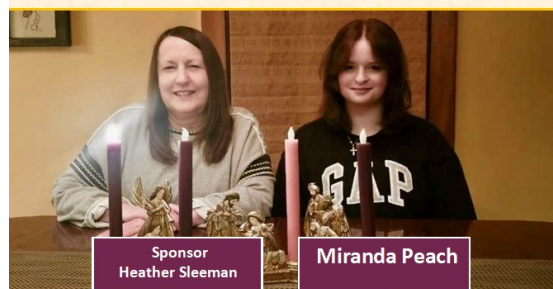
4. What is your favorite Bible verse?

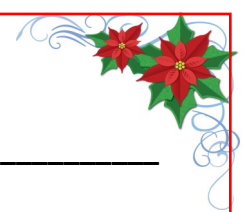

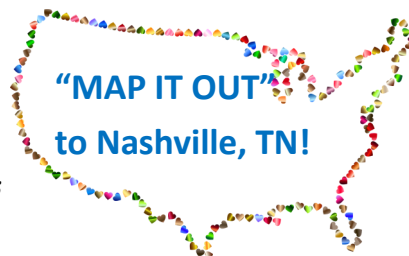

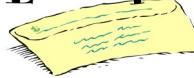
