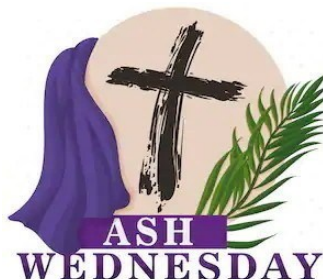


A Lenten Prayer Partner is an individual with whom you share in prayer during the Lenten season. It is a way to deepen your own prayer life while also providing comfort and support to others.

# PASTORAL PONDERINGS

Imagine your spiritual life as a home. When cared for, it's a place of peace and safety, but neglect can leave it in disrepair. Dust gathers, rooms grow cluttered, and broken fixtures are ignored. Eventually the house no longer feels like a home. In the same way, when God is pushed aside, our spiritual life becomes disordered, and peace gives way to anxiety, sin, or discouragement.

Renewal begins when we invite Christ back in. He doesn't come as a harsh inspector but as a loving Savior who helps us see what needs healing. Some rooms are easy to open, while others remain locked filled with guilt, wounds, or unhealthy habits. Through prayer and honest reflection, Christ walks with us, opening each door and offering forgiveness and restoration.

The sacraments are the key to this renewal. Confession clears away years of clutter, restoring light to the soul. The Eucharist strengthens the foundation, giving grace to rebuild what is weak. Over time, the house becomes orderly again, not perfect, but alive and welcoming.

True freedom isn't found in control, but in surrender to Christ. When He is at the center, the soul becomes a dwelling place of peace. He restores what is broken, renews hearts daily, and patiently guides His people toward lasting joy and holiness.

If you're longing for renewal and deeper connection this Lent, join us for our new Discipleship Small Groups. The kickoff session is Tuesday, February 24 at 5:30 PM at Kaudy Hall in Winneconne. Dinner will be provided, and ongoing sessions will be held in Omro and Winneconne.

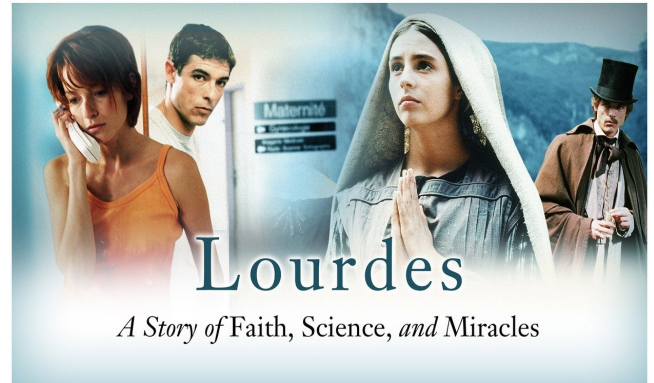
# ADULT FAITH FORMATION

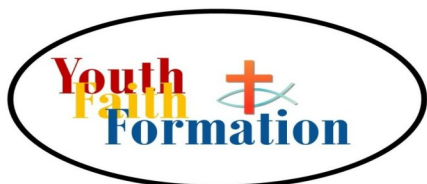
