

PASTORAL PONDERINGS

The Catholic Church has devoted the entire month of May for centuries to honor Mary the Blessed Mother of God. The custom of honoring this time of year, when nature renews itself, has been practiced for centuries across cultures. For instance, in Ancient Rome, May was dedicated to Flora, the goddess of blossoms. The people would hold a festival of "flora" games and would ask Flora to intercede for all that grows. In ancient Greece, May was dedicated to Artemis, a goddess of fertility.



Many of these pagan practices centered around the transition from winter to spring, the time of new growth and new life. The Catholic Church has always used elements of pagan culture that are not opposed to the Catholic Faith, and refocused them so as to honor the one true God. It makes sense that this long-time practice of honoring new growth and motherhood would lead to honoring Mary, who gave new life to the world when she gave birth to our Savior Jesus Christ.

During the middle ages the tradition of "Tricesimum," or "Thirty-Day Devotion to Mary" arose. The praying of the rosary was the center of this 30 day devotion but the 30 days were celebrated at different times of the year in different places.

The May devotion to Mary that we practice today originated near the end of the 18th century at a Jesuit college in Rome. Father Latomia, of the Roman College of the Society of Jesus, vowed to devote the month of May to Mary in order to bring conversion to the immorality he saw among the students. This practice spread quickly to other Jesuit colleges, and then extended throughout the Church. The Church honors Mary as the Mother of God, looks to her as a model of perfect discipleship, and asks for her prayers to God on our behalf.

There are two traditional ways that Mary is honored during the month of May and our parishes practice both. First: parishes, small groups, families, and individuals pray the rosary during this month. Second: there is a "May Crowning," when the statue of Mary is crowned with flowers. This tradition reenacts Mary's coronation in heaven. The flowers represent Mary's beauty and virtue and the ceremony invites us to imitate Mary's virtue in our lives. The beauty of this month-long devotion is that there is no set way to celebrate. So, be creative and make it fun. Above all, just talk with our heavenly mother this month. Tell Mary everything that is on your heart and ask her to bring you closer to Jesus.

Next weekend, as we recognize and honor moms, grandmothers, stepmoms, mothers-to-be and all women who encompass the qualities of motherhood, let us intentionally honor our Blessed Mother Mary throughout May. Let us all pray to Mary because she is our mother. She cares for us as only a mother can and she intercedes for us. By practicing this month-long devotion to Mary, the core values of the faith will become more alive within you and Mary's love through you will help bring others to Jesus.


