

Last Sunday we celebrated the **<u>Rite of Acceptance</u>**, for those previously known as inquirers who are now <u>catechumens</u> seeking the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, 1st Communion.) They have been officially welcomed by the Church as disciples, members, yet not full members, of the household of faith. They have been marked with the cross of Christ as God's own.

For those baptized in other Christian traditions, we celebrated **<u>the Rite of Welcome</u>**. For them the signing of the Cross signifies their commitment to deepen their relationship with Christ. These <u>candidates</u> are seeking full communion in the Catholic Church and will complete the sacraments of initiation (Confirmation, 1st Communion.)

# **PASTORAL PONDERINGS**

The season of Advent is rising on the horizon. As a Parish Community we will be encouraged to spend the year as people who *RECEIVE*, *RENEW* and *REJOICE*. The premise, while very simple, is challenging to live out. Each time we **RECEIVE** Jesus into our lives, every part of our mind, body, and soul can be & *is* renewed. In that we **REJOICE** as we strive to live more deeply as People of the Gospel.

As we begin this Advent journey we will be looking to Mary as a model of how we should be living Advent. Mary **RECEIVED** the invitation from God to be the Christ bearer. In her "yes" she was **RENEWED** by God, in every way necessary, as she **REJOICED** in the role, she was being called to fulfill in Salvation History.

Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI said, "To celebrate Advent means: to become Marian, to enter that communion with Mary's 'Yes,' which, ever new, is room for God's birth, for the 'fullness of time.'" This Advent each of us can seek out and honor the responsibility we have as a Christ bearer.

Within our Parish church you will experience three things unique to this year and our union with the Advent Mary.

You will see the Advent Wreath covered in fruit. This style is called Della Robia and is credited to Luca Della Robia, a 15<sup>th</sup> century Italian sculptor, who encircled sculptures of Mary and Jesus with Fruit. The symbolism

is twofold. First, it is within the deep center of the fruit that the seeds of potential life for the next generation are held. Inside each of us, in our deepest center of soul, lies the mystery of Jesus Christ, whom we are called to make known to all people. Secondly, the fruit reminds us of the nine Fruits of the Spirit that are to be part of our daily living. "The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control." (Galatians 5:22)



Each Sunday of Advent we will begin Mass by singing the hymn "Mary the Dawn." While Jesus was the one who accomplished salvation, Mary played an important supportive role, in bringing the Messiah into the world. The song "Mary the Dawn," written by Fr. Justin Mulcahy, C.P. in the mid-20th century, is a beautiful expression of the relationship between Mary and Jesus. Many images are taken right from the Old Testament. For example, the song says, "Mary the dawn, Christ the perfect day." This is classic Marian theology; Mary became the means for Christ to enter the world in perfection and completeness.

For the past several seasons of Advent and Lent we have had a Rosary Tree available for people. You have been encouraged to take a rosary and during the week pray for the specific intention or person that was attached to it. With our focus being on Mary, in particular the pregnant Mary of Advent, the intentions on our rosaries will be for women who are pregnant or for men and women who are awaiting a child through adoption. Your rosary may have the name of a woman or family from our community that has requested our prayers, or you may have an intention for women outside of the community who are pregnant, in a difficult health situation related to pregnancy, those dealing with a pregnancy resulting from violence etc.

This year the Season of Advent is short. The 4<sup>th</sup> week of Advent will only last from our 4 PM Mass on Saturday until our Christmas Eve Mass the next afternoon. People are going to be moving at a more frantic pace to get all the things done that they feel are needed to have an enjoyable Christmas season. Please make some time each week to come to Mass, so that you too can have the opportunity to quietly contemplate, as Mary did, the wonderous work that God is doing in your life. Come Lord Jesus, be born in us anew.


