PASTORAL PONDERINGS

Advent is a time of waiting, preparation, and hope. We await Jesus' coming as a baby on Christmas Day, as well as the end of time. We look back in time 2,000 years ago to see that Jesus was born into a family of simple means and yet was the Son of God. We celebrate and recognize Jesus' coming at a moment of history and use Advent to remind us that God (Emanuel) is always with us. Our Advent journey is rooted in preparation and hope for the coming of Jesus.

As we journey this year during Advent one of the ways to prepare and fill our days with hope is to use the Advent wreath. The Advent wreath is a long-standing tradition and its symbolism is beautiful. The wreath is made of various evergreens signifying continuous everlasting life. The laurels signify victory over persecution and suffering; the pine holly and yew immortality; and cedar: strength and healing. The prickly leaves remind us of the crown of thorns and the red berries, the blood of our Savior. The circle of the wreath which has no beginning or end symbolizes the eternity of God, the immortality of our Soul, and the new everlasting life offered by Christ.

The four candles represent the four weeks of Advent. During the first week of Advent we light a purple candle as we look forward to Jesus' coming with hope. The second week we light another purple candle which is the candle of peace. During the second week we reflect on our lives and how we can become a better version of ourselves in preparation of Jesus' coming. The third week we light the pink candle which is the candle of joy. This candle symbolizes our increased anticipation and rejoicing. During the third week we are filled with joy for the upcoming arrival of Jesus on Christmas Day. The fourth week of Advent we light the remaining purple candle which is the candle of love. During this final week we rejoice in the endless love that God has for us which is apparent in the birth of his son.

Advent starts the first weekend in December. Might you consider this Advent season to invest in an Advent wreath which serves as a powerful reminder of the holiness of the season? The light of the candles invites us to quiet ourselves during this busy time and reflect on the true meaning of Christmas. Whether at home or at church it provides an invitation to wait and pray in hopeful anticipation of the coming of Jesus.






