PASTORAL PONDERINGS

I had a horrible day recently. I was subjected to verbal abuse like I have never experienced before. Slander and out right hate (disguised as good intentions) were laid on me as well.

I do not want to appear as if I am trying to get even – <u>but I want to make public who did this to me.</u> It was...my very own computer. Things started out calmly enough, I was looking for pictures of the Blessed Mother. As it turned out one of the sites, I was exploring also had discussion links attached. It is my own fault for even beginning to read them, but the discussion was about the Blessed Mother (for heaven's sake) what's not to love? But as I continued to read the words began to hit me. So many people, enthusiastic about their particular cause, heaped hate and wrath upon others who had a divergent view. Horrible

things were said about people, often with an opinion or hearsay, rather than founded on facts. Yet by being able to promote their ideas anonymously and on a public forum, many others who will read what was said believe that they are speaking the full truth. What I found humbling was a post made by someone who stated clearly," I am an atheist and I feel it is hateful and disrespectful for



human beings to talk to one another in such a manner." I thought to myself "in particular when the people making the posts proclaim they are a Christian."

The Internet, Instagram, Facebook, Blogs, and Tweets provide us with a wonderful opportunity to share God's compassion and to reflect the Faith, Hope and Charity, which have sustained the Roman Catholic Church. But instead, many people who claim to bear the name Christian have turned to using these forums as a storehouse of verbal weapons, containing various forms of sarcasm ranging from mild mockery to outright ridicule.

As Catholics the Church enjoins us to be people who defend and protect the lives of our most vulnerable. What we need to remember is that every person is vulnerable in one way or another. One does not build up the Body of Christ by sending out hurtful or judgmental words that in effect can contribute to the "breaking and killing of another's spirit."

Author Steven Aitchison stated, "Your words have the power to hurt, to heal, open minds, open hearts and change the world. Never forget the responsibility you have over the words you speak." And even more importantly God has stated "See I have put my words into your mouth" (Jer. 1:9) These are the very words of "The WORD [who] was made flesh and dwelt among us." Our words have power. May we use them wisely.






