

PASTORAL PONDERINGS

I understand that everyone is busy and that we already have a to-do-list that is long. Below is a list of Catholic things to consider doing every day and it is not meant to make you feel guilty. The goal is to start doing one or two of these ideas each day and then keep adding until these actions become a natural part of your day. I invite you to consider making them essential healthy habits, like brushing your teeth, so you do not even have to think about doing them.

- Pray everyday from your heart, with the bible, and be sure to talk with your mother. Our days need to be centered on this habit. Set your cell phone alarm to a time that works to pray and do not forget about God. Mornings work best for me, but if it does not for you then find a time what works. Read a line or two from your bible. Tell God what is on your heart. Say at least one Hail Mary, work your way up to a decade, and then the whole rosary.
- They will know we are Christians by our love so why not smile, use our manners, and be kind. Some Christians have become just as rude and inconsiderate as everyone else; sometimes even more so. I invite us to share words of appreciation or encouragement with people, let others go ahead of us in line, and not criticize, condemn, or complain.
- **Tell someone you love them and why.** I do not know anyone who has ever gotten tired of hearing they are loved. It's even better when they are given a list of reasons why! Whether it's your parents, siblings, or your own children, make it a daily habit to tell at least one person in your life how much you love them and why.
- **Talk about God.** Make God a part of your whole day, not only at prayer time. Bring him into your conversations with friends, family, even coworkers if you are able. We talk about things we love like movies, restaurants, and people, but we often fail to talk about God in the same way.
- **Sacrifice something.** It is so important that we learn to make daily sacrifices and offer them up to the Lord. It doesn't have to be anything crazy. Maybe it's not eating sweets for the day, turning off the music and driving in silence, or finding time to serve someone. It's the little things that cultivate our holiness and help us overcome our attachments to the things of this world.
- **Reflect on your day.** At the end of every day, take a few minutes to think back over the day. Ask yourself, is there someone you need to forgive? Is there someone you need to seek forgiveness from? What can I thank God for today? Did I move closer or further away from God through my words or actions today? How can I do better tomorrow?

I invite us to align our days here on Earth to match what we want our days in eternity to look like. By creating these habits in our current lifestyle may they reflect our hope of spending eternity in heaven with God the Father.




